SEVEN VIET CONG WERE KILLED BY ALFA GROUP RIVERINE FORCES
ON FRIDAY, 29 NOVEMBER. THE 3/34 ARTILLERY BATTALION WAS
CREDITED WITH 5 OF THESE DURING A HARASSMENT AND INTERDICTION
MISSION APPROXIMATELY 4 KILOMETERS NW OF BEN TRE.

AIR ACTION ACCOUNTED FOR 2 VC KIA'S AND THE DESTRUCTION
OF 6 ENEMY STRUCTURES.

IN GROUP BRAVO ACTIVITY ON 27 NOVEMBER, SEAWOLVES PROVIDED
