MAJOR MARSHAL G. HARRISON - Major U.S. Armed Forces
(Effective on 26 June 1970)

Major Marshal G. Harrison is a courageous pilot/observer, participating in almost all the operations established by the 3rd Attack Battalion, specifically in an operation on 18 April 1970 at target D.70. After completing his air reconnaissance mission, he was nominated to another mission in support of a reconnaissance team when this team came in contact with a large enemy force. Although his aircraft was low on fuel and was receiving heavy ground fire, Major Marshal G. Harrison was still calm and managed to direct the helicopter gunship in accurately strafing the enemy positions. Through Major Harrison's gallantry, the Vietnamese team survived safely and also caused great damage to the enemy force.
