Thanks for your letter, undated, received here on December 8, 1969, concerning Miss Kathy Toan. I have talked to the Language Division, and they advise that there are no immediate openings, and that when openings arise they will try to fill them first with Vietnamese men in order to balance the instructor staff. In any case, applicants have been customarily hired here in the States in accordance with the attached procedures. Dr. Howard Levy, Chairman of the Language Division here at VTC, expects to arrive in Viet-Nam on January 7 to spend several weeks in the country. He has said that he will be very pleased to meet Miss Toan. He has your office address, and I would suggest that you keep on the lookout for him after January 7.

I am very glad you are enjoying your tour with CORDS/CDD. Please remember me most cordially to Dick Evans. Dick is a mine of information and is the senior American in Viet-Nam in point of length of service. Please keep in touch and let us know how you are getting along and give us any suggestions you may have for improving our course.
