Dear Jack:

This letter is to inform you that T. Edward Strinko, FSR-6, age 26, expects to arrive in Viet-Nam on or about December 15 and is scheduled for refugee adviser work. We at VTC are confident that Mr. Strinko will be a great asset to any province team and wish to forward his area preferences. He would like to work in any of the coastal provinces of II Corps. He is a former Peace Corps man with an excellent attitude, cooperative spirit, and no problems. He was not outstanding in language, which accounts in part for his earlier assignment to the field. The remaining members of his long-term class (CORDS XIX) would not normally be going out until next May. I hope you can give due consideration to his assignment preference as he is a worthy candidate.

Another candidate, Jeffrey V. Millington, FSR-7, believes he is being assigned to Chau Doc Province, with which he is already familiar, and has been learning Cambodian on his own time. He is another excellent candidate whom we can heartily recommend.

Within a few days I will send you evaluations on CORDS XVIII personnel and any others who may be due to leave VTC in the near future.
