Staff Appointments

Effective this date, Mr. Raymond G. Jones is joining the VTC staff as Deputy Coordinator for Management. Mr. Jones's duties in this new post will include acting as Coordinator in the Coordinator's absence and exercising general management of VTC operational and administrative affairs. Mr. Jones will be responsible for rating Course Chairmen and the Administrative Officer.

Effective this date, Mr. James A. May will assume duties as Deputy Coordinator for Instruction. He will be responsible, under the Coordinator and Deputy Coordinator for Management, for the substantive content of all VTC training courses and activities. In their absence he will act as Coordinator, VTC, and will assist the Coordinator and Deputy Coordinator for Management in all other operational and administrative activities of the Viet-Nam Training Center. He will be rated by the Coordinator.

Mr. Jones, a retired Colonel in the US Army, comes to VTC from Saigon where he served most recently as Director, Chieu Hoi, CORDS, MACV. He joined AID in Viet-Nam in June, 1967, after two previous military tours in that country. Brought up in Colorado, Mr. Jones received his BS degree in Engineering from Harvard in 1939 and was commissioned in the Regular Army in 1941. His military career assignments include Secretary General Staff, CONARC, Ft. Monroe, Va.; Aviation Officer, XVIII Abn Corps, Ft. Bragg; Deputy J-3 MACV; CO, 12th Aviation Group (Viet-Nam); and Special Liaison Officer to General Duong Van Minh, Chief of State, Republic of Viet-Nam. He is both airborne and aviation qualified. Mr. Jones's decorations include: Distinguished Service Medal; Legion of Merit; Silver Star with Oak Leaf Cluster; Distinguished Flying Cross; Bronze Star with two Oak Leaf Clusters; Air Medal with 12 Oak Leaf Clusters; and Presidential Distinguished Unit Citation.
