Dear Professor Honey:

I am informed that you have already spoken to our students at the Viet-Nam Training Center (VTC), Foreign Service Institute, here in Washington, and I am writing to inquire whether you would be able to do so again. Our student body consists of both military and civilian personnel who will be going to Viet-Nam to serve in advisory roles at various levels, and it would be extremely valuable for them and us to receive an estimate of the situation in North Viet-Nam from an acknowledged expert on the subject. The precise focus of your remarks would be entirely up to you.

Under the regulations governing the Foreign Service Institute, we would be able to send you an air ticket from London to Washington and return, and would suggest that you spend two days with us to address the VTC student body on the first day and the Senior Seminar in Foreign Policy on the second day. You would be allowed per diem expenses of \$25 a day, plus an honorarium of \$150 per day. We would propose February 12 and 13 as the dates for your appearances at VTC and the Senior Seminar, if that is convenient to you. If these dates are not satisfactory, could you suggest alternative later dates?

Your appearance here would constitute a great contribution to our program, and we would be delighted to have you with us if the above proposal meets with your approval. I would much appreciate hearing from you at your early convenience and hope that your response will be affirmative.
