Dear Colonel Waller:

We were glad to have your letter indicating that your sojourn at the Viet-Nam Training Center was useful and stimulating, and were interested to hear that you will shortly be taking up a new assignment as a Corps-level advisor. We were sorry to hear of your misfortune and the loss of your library in the warehouse fire. Perhaps the documents which we are forwarding to you under separate cover will at least in some measure alleviate that loss. The enclosed rather comprehensive bibliography should also give you a good focus for the replenishing of your library.

There is an Army Handbook for Cambodia (DA PAM No. 550-50) which can be obtained from the Superintendent of Documents, U.S. Government Printing Office, Washington, D.C., (\$3.00) which would give you the history, the general character of the society, and the political and economic development of the country.

In regard to area studies on the Mekong Delta, you will find references to the area in some of the documents we are sending. There is also a post-war economic plan published by the Joint (US/Vietnamese) Development Group (the so-called Lilienthal Report) which you might find of interest. Copies should be obtained from the Development and Resources Corporation, New York (Attention: Mr. David Lilienthal, Chairman).

If we can be of any more help, please let us know.
