TO WHOM IT MAY CONCERN

This is to affirm that during 1969-1971, I drew two checks in the amount of \$1,500 and \$1,000, respectively, made out to Lynn Sobotta with the request that the checks be cashed and the proceeds given to Vietnamese citizens in the United States, in return for which relatives of those citizens would pay the equivalent in piastres to Miss Trinh Thanh Nhan in Saigon, Viet-Nam. Miss Trinh Thanh Nhan is the sister of Mrs. Lynn Sobotta. Miss Trinh Thanh Nhan advised me on both occasions that the full value in piastres was duly paid to her in Saigon. The purpose of these transactions was to assist Miss Trinh Thanh Nhan while assuring that the dollar instruments never left the United States, which was the case.
