
Dear Mrs. Williams:

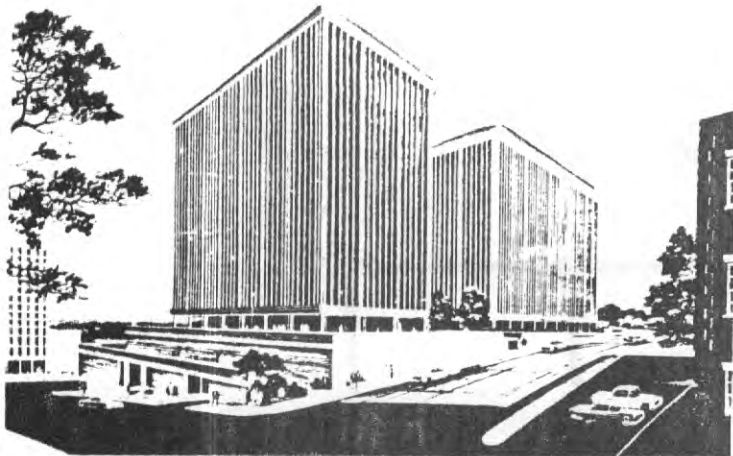

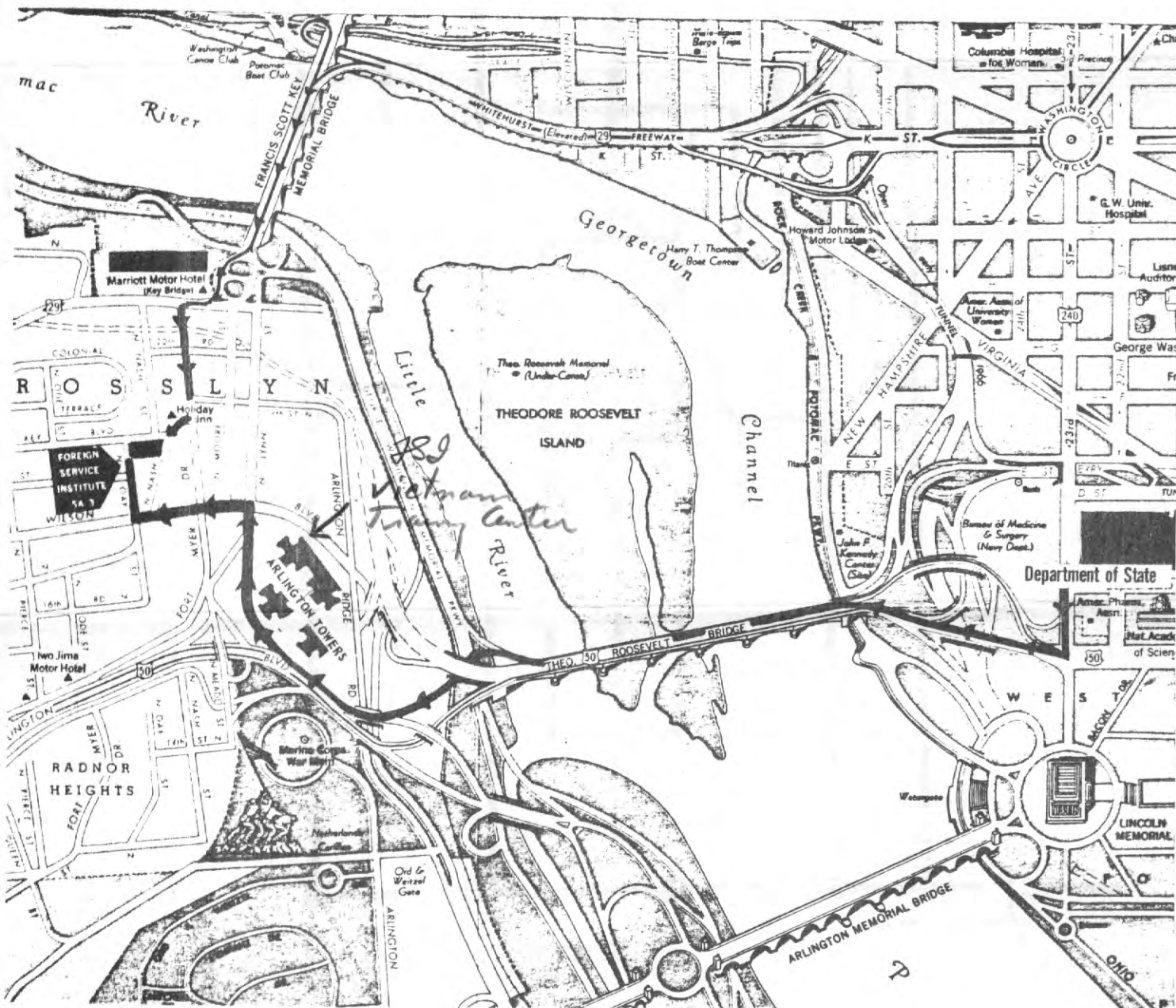

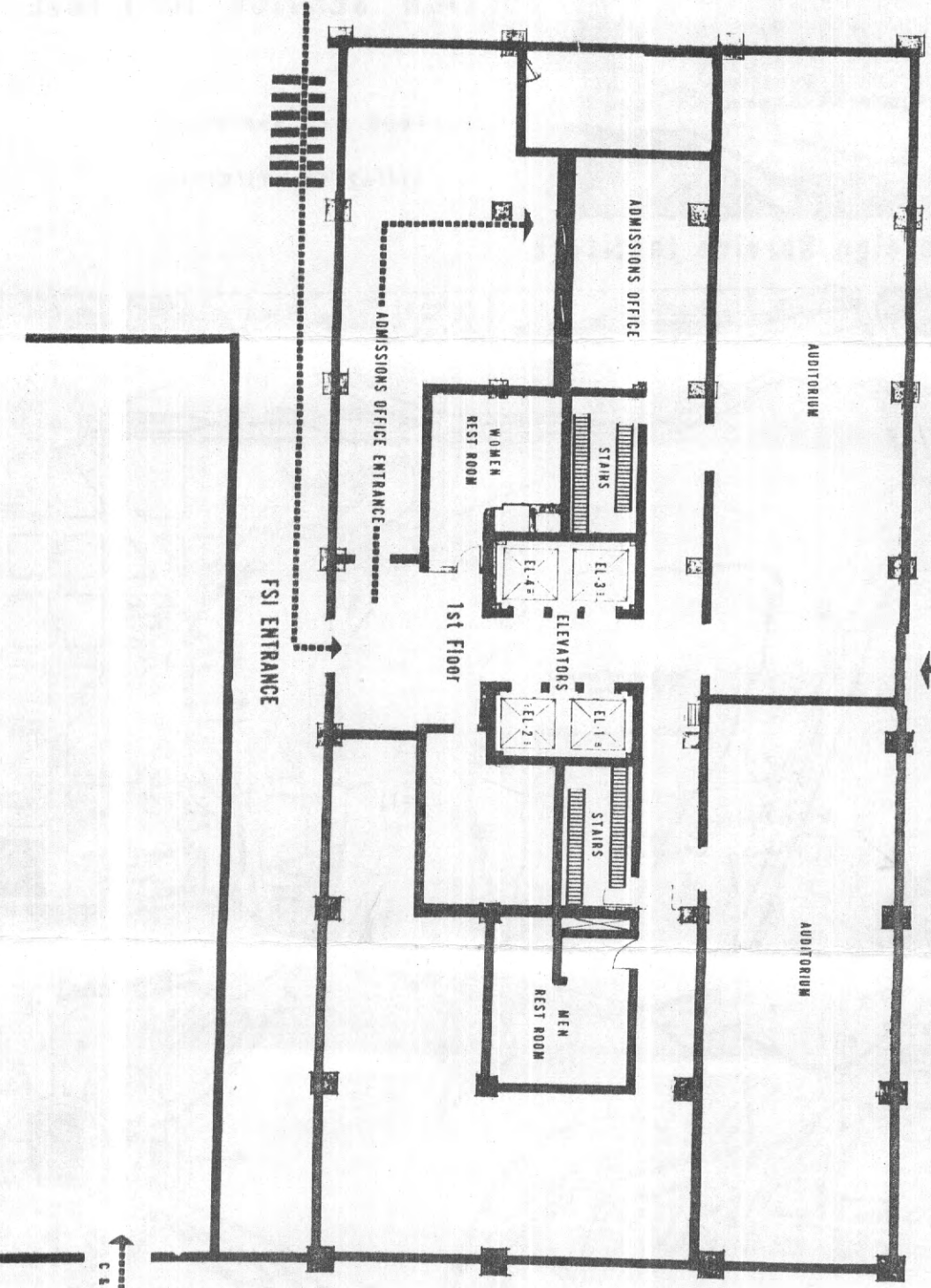
