EXTRACT

8. The following-named officers, Air Corps (AUS), are rated Aircraft Observers (Aerial Navigators), under the provisions of Army Regulations 95-60, War Department, 1942, and paragraph 3k (3) (b), Army Air Forces Regulation 50-7, dated September 11, 1942, Effective November 1, 1942.

9. Pursuant to authority contained in paragraph 2, Army Regulations 35-1480, dated November 21, 1932, the following-named officers, Air Corps (AUS), each of whom holds an aeronautical rating, are hereby required to participate in regular and frequent aerial flights, at such times as they are called to active duty with the Army Air Forces, U.S. Army, under competent authority, and are authorized to participate in regular and frequent aerial flights while on an inactive status, in accordance with the provisions of paragraph 52, A.R. 95-15, dated April 21, 1930.

All orders in conflict with this order are revoked.
