INVESTIGATOR'S STATEMENT

On 3 Jan 70 an interview with Truong TONG, conducted through SA Nicholas A. VONTEZALIDES, Interpreter, at LZ Bayonet, RVN, began at 1045 hours and terminated at 1130 hours. TONG's personal data is:

TONG stated substantially as follows: He was captured by some American soldiers on 3 Jan 70 and is being held a PW. He formerly lived in My Khe #3 with his wife Nguyen Thi TONG, age 42; his daughter Truong Thi TIEN, age 17; and his sons Truong NGOC, age 11; Truong CU, age 3; and Truong CUI, age 1. The home was located at the base of a mountain and a highway ran close by the mountain. He could not furnish any date except to say that early one morning about two years ago his wife and daughter TIEN left home to go to another village. He went to work in the rice fields. During the late afternoon his wife and daughter had not returned home and he walked up the highway to try and locate them. He could not recall how long he was walking or how far up the highway he had walked, but he found his wife and daughter dead with bullet holes all over their bodies. He has no idea who killed them or how it may have happened. From this point on he cried continually and he would not respond to questions. There was a short break in the interview, but when it was continued he sat on the floor and cried. The interview was terminated. An attempt made by Invst MOSES to interview TONG on 2 Jan 70 was unsuccessful due to TONG's high emotional state. A photograph of TONG was obtained.
