INVESTIGATOR'S STATEMENT

On 12 Jan 70 an interview with Pham Thi LOM, conducted through SA Nicholas A. VONTZALIDES, Interpreter, began at 1300 hours and terminated at 1415 hours. LOM's personal data is:

LOM stated substantially as follows: She recalled that American soldiers had been to Tu Cung about three times. The first two times there was no trouble. The next time they came was over a year ago and this time they killed people in the village. On this occasion she was in her home with her father Pham DAT, age 41; her mother Phung Thi LY, age unknown; her sisters Pham Thi XI (AKA: CHI); and Pham Thi XIEU (AKA: DU), and her brother Pham DANH, age 4. XI and XIEU are age 7 and age 1, respectively. About five caucasian soldiers came to her home and took the entire family to a ~~surrounding~~ clearing outside the village and made them sit next to a ditch. There were many villagers of all ages at the ditch and the soldiers made them get into the ditch after they had been there a while. She estimated there were about ten soldiers with the people at the ditch and some of them were negro. Then the soldiers began shooting the people in the ditch. She said they had rifles like the ones in the photographs of the scene which she viewed. She indicated they used M-16 rifles. She was shot in the left thigh and some dead people fell on top of her. She was too scared to move and just stayed there until the soldiers left. Then she heard villagers calling out for people who were still alive and she pulled herself out of the ditch. Some unknown villagers found her and took her to a hospital in Quang Ngai. About two days later her father found her in the hospital where he was also being treated for wounds received from the soldiers. Her father told her that her mother and her sister XIEU were killed by the soldiers and that XI and DANH were wounded by the soldiers. Some time after she got out of the hospital she returned to Tu Cung by herself to see her home and found that it had been destroyed. She could not recall any further information concerning the incident. She was not oriented to the sketch of Tu Cung and she could not identify any persons or buildings in the photographs of the scene. A photograph of LOM was obtained.
