SWORN STATEMENT

I, Kenneth Paul McMullen, WANT TO MAKE THE FOLLOWING STATEMENT UNDER OATH:

INVESTIGATOR'S STATEMENT

On 18 Jan 70 an interview with Pham LE, conducted through SA Nicholas A. VONZALIDIS, Interpreter, began at 1325 hours and terminated at 1430 hours. LE's personal data is:

LE stated substantially as follows: About 0600 hours, the 18th day of the second month of the lunar calendar, two years ago he heard airplanes flying in the vicinity of his Hamlet of Binh Dong. He looked outside his home and saw an unknown number of helicopters in the air, but did not see them land. In his home with him at this time was his wife Do Thi UYEN, age 58; his son Pham XI, age 10; his daughter Pham Thi THIEN, age 7; his son Pham CHIEN, age 26; and the wife of CHIEN, Nguyen Thi BA, age 26. CHIEN and BA remained in Binh Dong, which is located east of Thuan Yen (Tu Cung), but he and the other members of his family fled the Hamlet to the fields. He did not see any of the American soldiers that day, but while they were hiding in the fields he heard a lot of gunfire in the Hamlet. During the mid afternoon he returned to his home and found his son CHIEN dead, in the home, from a gunshot wound. The three family water buffalo were shot and killed. His home and the buffalo shed had been destroyed by fire. He found BA dead in the home of her father along with the dead bodies of her father Do NGUYEN, age 65 and BA's mother Nguyen Thi DAI, age 60. They had all been shot. This home was also destroyed by fire and the bodies in the home were partially burnt by fire. He buried BA, NGUYEN, and DAI in the southern portion of the Hamlet and CHIEN just north of the Hamlet. He could locate the graves if returned to Binh Dong. He does not know how many people were killed that day, but he did see several other unknown dead bodies in the Hamlet. He knew of no rapes committed by American soldiers and does not recall them ever being in the Hamlet before. He knew of no Viet Cong ever being in the Hamlet. After burying the bodies he went to Son Hoa with his wife and children and stayed with a friend for a while and later settled in Son My Model Village. In photograph frame #25A he identified the first Vietnamese male from the right as Nguyen THIENH, age unknown, who he now believes is residing in Son My Model Village. He could furnish no additional information pertinent to this investigation. A photograph of LE was obtained.
