SWORN STATEMENT

I, THOMAS J. MCGARRY, WANT TO MAKE THE FOLLOWING STATEMENT UNDER OATH:

On 19 Jan 70, I went to the Chien Hoi Center in Tu Nghia District, Quang Ngai Province, RVN. A search of the records revealed that Pham Cao (mentioned by Nam Day when he was interviewed by Investigator Moses on 18 Jan 70) is not and never has been at the Chien Hoi Center. His whereabouts are not known.

On 19 Jan 70, between 1300 and 1500 hrs, Nguyen Co (also known as Nguyen Khac Thong) was reinterviewed by me, with S/A Arthur D. Harris of the 25th MI Det, AFO 96225, acting as interpreter. Nguyen Co had been previously interviewed on 15 Jan 70 by CID Investigator A. J. Kink. The interview on 19 Jan 70 was conducted solely to give Nguyen Co an opportunity to identify any individuals or structures he might be able to recognize in the Heberle black-and-white and color photographs.

Nguyen Co examined the photographs and was able to make the following identifications:

ROEL #1, Heberle's black-and-white photographs:

- Frame 30A-In Thuan Yen; Truong Xung's house (#23 on Do Vien's map).
- Frame 31A-In Thuan Yen; the front entrance to Truong Long's house (#22 on Do Vien's map).
- Frame 32A-In Thuan Yen; the rear of Truong Long's house (#22 on Do Vien's map).
- Frame 33A-In Thuan Yen; the courtyard in back of Truong Chau's house (#33 on Do Vien's map).
- Frame 34A-In Thuan Yen; Truong Chau and 2 of his grandchildren. All three are alive and living in Saigon.
- Frame 35A-In Thuan Yen; Truong Chau and 2 of his grandchildren. Photo was taken next to Truong Chau's house (#33 on Do Vien's map).

ROEL #2, Heberle's in black-and-white photographs:

- Frame 1-In Thuan Yen; portion of the garden near Truong Chau's house (#33 on Do Vien's map).
- Frame 1A-In Thuan Yen; Truong Tho's garden, approx 50 meters from Truong Tho's house (#21 on Do Vien's map), between Truong Tho's house and the pagoda.
- Frame 2A-In Thuan Yen; same location as previous frame.

Frame 11A-At south edge of Thuan Yen, near Do Phu's house (#38 on Do Vien's map).

Frame 12A-Doesn't recognize anything familiar.

Frame 13A-Doesn't recognize anything familiar.

Frame 14A-Doesn't recognize anything familiar.

Frame 15A-In Thuan Yen; man shown is Pham Lai, at the house of Pham Di (#23 on Do Vien's map). Pham Lai was killed that day (16 Mar 68) by the Americans.

Frame 16A-Same as previous frame.

Frame 17A-In Thuan Yen; Pham Lai sitting on the ground just south of Pham Di's house (#23 on Do Vien's map). The garden shared by Le Thi Xie and Pham Di is shown to the right of the path.

Frame 18A-In Thuan Yen; watchtower at point where main north-south trail enters the southern edge of Thuan Yen is in background. Watchtower was about five meters high on 16 Mar 68; the top part is hidden by the trees. The photograph was taken from in front of Do Phu's house (#33 on Do Vien's map).

Frame 19A-In Thuan Yen; Do Phu's house at south edge of Thuan Yen, just east of the main north-south trail.

Frame 20A-Doesn't know the people, but they are not residents of Thuan Yen.

Frame 21A-Doesn't know the man with the Americans, but he is not a resident of Thuan Yen.

Statement of McCreary, 19 Jan 70, at Quang Ngai, RVN, Cont'd:

Frame 22A-Doesn't know the boy with the soldiers, but he is not a resident of Thuan Yen.

Frame 23A-Doesn't recognize the location, but it is not in Thuan Yen.

Frame 24A-Doesn't recognize the location ~~or~~ or the people with the soldiers, but it is not in Thuan Yen.

Frame 25A-Third man from left is Quang Vu of Binh Dong sub-hamlet, east of Thuan Yen. Doesn't recognize other men and boys with the soldiers, but they are not residents of Thuan Yen.
