SWORN STATEMENT

I, Coy L. WELLS, WANT TO MAKE THE FOLLOWING STATEMENT UNDER OATH:

Between 1315 - 1340 hours, 14 Mar 70, I interviewed Le Thi BON in the presence of SP6 Raymond O. WALDEN acting as interpreter. Personal data of BON is as follows:

BON stated substantially as follows: She remembers the date that the Americans came to My Hoi and killed the women and children, since she lost members of her family. It was the 18th day of the 2nd lunar month of 1968. On that day she went to the market about four kilometers to the north of My Hoi. She departed at the time the sun was first up and returned at about 1800 hours. She did not see any Americans, helicopters, fires or firing. Upon her return to My Hoi, she discovered that many homes had been burned, crops destroyed and many persons killed. She lost five members of her family, they were: Vo Thi THU, 60, her mother; Pham Thi HOA, 40, sister; Le Thi LY, 43, her sister; Ngo THIEP, 22, nephew and Vo CAU, 5 months, nephew. She found them in the family bunker, did not know how they had been killed. There was excitement in the air, expecting the Americans to return. She buried the members of her family who perished that day and then went to Co Phu, where she has remained since.

BON was shown the picture of Nguyen Thi TY (AKA: Nguyen Thi BAY) and identified her as TY. She stated that she knew TY in the hamlet and spoke to her many times - she had heard that TY had been raped by a negro soldier however she had no personal knowledge concerning that. She had not seen TY since the incident. BON also stated that she had later heard that a count had been made of the dead and that 97 persons lost their lives that day in My Hoi, however while she saw "many" she did not count them. BON could offer no additional information and affirmed that her statement is true to the best of her knowledge and belief.
