Comes now the accused through defense counsel and introduces as an appellate exhibit, Harpers Magazine, Volume 240, Number 1440, May 1970, My Lai 4: A Report on the Massacre and its Aftermath, for consideration by Your Honor as evidence relating to defense's motions regarding prejudicial news reporting and command control, or for such other evidentiary weight as to all other matters for appropriate relief, including but not limited to motions for discovery, as to which said Article may circumstantially or directly relate. It should be noted that the Article refers to the writer's access to official government documents and quotes allegedly from CID, IG, and apparently "Peers" investigative material. This magazine appears not only locally but was openly sold in a Pentagon newsstand where it could affect personnel who will act in the appellate and executive clemency aspects of this case in the event of any findings other than an acquittal.
