Before a general court-martial which assembled at Fort Blank, Missouri, pursuant to Court-Martial Convening Order No. 12, Headquarters, 20th Infantry Division and Fort Blank, 27 August 1969, as amended by Court-Martial Convening Order No. 13, Headquarters, 20th Infantry Division and Fort Blank, 3 September 1969, was arraigned and tried:

Private (E-2) John Doe, SSAN: , U. S. Army, Company A, 1st Battalion, 66th Infantry.

Charge I: Violation of the Uniform Code of Military Justice, Article 85.

Specification: In that Private (E-2) John Doe, U.S. Army, Company A, 1st Battalion, 66th Infantry, did, on or about 6 June 1969, without proper authority and with intent to remain away therefrom permanently, absent himself from his organization, to wit: Company A, 1st Battalion, 66th Infantry, at Fort Blank, Missouri and did remain so absent in desertion until he was apprehended on or about September 1969.

Charge II: Violation of the Uniform Code of Military Justice, Article 121.

Specification: In that Private (E-2) John Doe, U.S. Army, Company A, 1st Battalion, 66th Infantry, did, at Fort Blank, Missouri, on or about 6 June 1969, steal a camera, of a value of about \$200, the property of Private (E-2) Henry Morgan.

PLEAS

To all the Specifications and Charges: Not guilty.

FINDINGS BY MILITARY JUDGE *

SENTENCE
