

Charge I : Violation of the Uniform Code of Military Justice, Article 120

Specification : In that Sergeant Charles E. Hutto, U.S. Army, Headquarters and Headquarters Company, 3d Advanced Individual Training Brigade, then a member of Company C, 1st Battalion, 20th Infantry, did, at My Lai (4), Republic of Vietnam, on or about 16 March 1968, rape a Vietnamese female person, whose name is unknown.

Charge II : Violation of the Uniform Code of Military Justice, Article 118

Specification: In that Sergeant Charles E. Hutto, U.S. Army, Headquarters and Headquarters Company, 3d Advanced Individual Training Brigade, then a member of Company C, 1st Battalion, 20th Infantry, did, at My Lai (4), Republic of Vietnam, on or about 16 March 1968, with premeditation, murder a Vietnamese female person, whose name is unknown, by shooting her with a rifle.

Charge III : Violation of the Uniform Code of Military Justice, Article 134

Specification: In that Sergeant Charles E. Hutto, U.S. Army, Headquarters and Headquarters Company, 3d Advanced Individual Training Brigade, then a member of Company C, 1st Battalion, 20th Infantry, did, at My Lai (4), Republic of Vietnam, on or about 16 March 1968, with intent to commit murder commit an assault upon a group of unidentified civilian Vietnamese men, women and children, whose names are unknown, by firing his weapon at them.
