Notice to Accused

Under the provisions of Uniform Code of Military Justice, article 67(c), and the Manual for Courts-Martial, United States, paragraph 100c(1)(a), the accused is hereby advised that he has thirty days from the time he is notified of the decision of the Navy Court of Military Review to petition the United States Court of Military Appeals for a grant of review with respect to any matter of law, such petition to be forwarded through the officer exercising immediate general court-martial jurisdiction over him and through the Judge Advocate General. Any request for Appellate Defense Counsel appointed by the Judge Advocate General or notification of retention of a named civilian counsel under the provisions of the Uniform Code of Military Justice, article 70(c)(1) and 70(d), should accompany a Petition for a Grant of Review. The accused should sign and date the enclosed postcard receipt and return it to JAG.
