
1. In accordance with your request contained in paragraph 1(b), the attached roster has been checked against the microfilm reader tape dated 15 April 1970 which are the ones presently being used by this headquarters. The roster has also been checked against our locator supplement file, which is a record of all personnel who have been separated from the service during the past six months.
2. In those instances where we show "no record", it means we can find no record of the individual presently being on active duty and we have no record of his separation or release from active duty during the last six months. The notation "transferred to USAAC" means the individual has been separated from active duty and his records transferred to the US Army Administration Center, 9700 Page Boulevard, St. Louis, Missouri 63132. Where the notation "HOR" (Home of Record) is followed by an address, it means that we still have an Official Military Personnel File on hand, however, no current military address is shown on the microfilm tape.
3. In reference to the items you requested in paragraph 1(a), please be advised that the copy of the DA Forms requested are not contained in the Official Military Personnel File of individuals on active duty. DA Forms 20 and 398 are items that are filed in a Military Personnel Records Jacket that is maintained by the unit of assignment in the field. There is no known requirement for DA Form 493 to be filed in either file.
4. In reference to your request as to which of the individuals were assigned to the unit in question as of March 1968, please be advised that this information is maintained on the DA Form 20 at his unit of assignment.
5. Information pertaining to the officers listed is not maintained by this office. Official files of officers still on active duty are maintained by the Personnel Records Division, Office of The Adjutant General, Washington, DC. (The mailing address is 3511 South Carlyn Spring Road, Falls Church, Virginia 22041) However, their field records which are maintained by the unit of assignment should contain the information you are requesting.
6. Records for personnel released from active duty are maintained by the US Army Administration Center, St. Louis, Missouri. Records for
