

1. Reference is made to previous requests from members of your section for CID investigators be made available on a full time basis to assigned defense counsel.
2. In this regard you are advised that such requests, on a "mission by mission" basis, will be considered by the Army Staff Judge Advocate on a proper showing of materiality, necessity, availability of investigative personnel, and scope of assistance requested, i.e., duration of TDY, distance to be traveled, etc. Such requests will receive full and equitable consideration.
3. All such requests may be made directly to the Army Staff Judge Advocate or the Deputy Army Staff Judge Advocate, and will be treated as confidential.
4. Investigations conducted pursuant to such requests; however, will be in accordance with applicable Army Regulations governing the CID Program.
5. Should counsel desire to conduct personal independent investigation in lieu of CID investigative assistance, requests for travel will be favorably considered upon a showing of materiality of the evidence sought to be obtained and submission of a specific itinerary. Matters presented to justify travel by military counsel will be treated in a confidential manner by the Staff Judge Advocate, the Deputy Staff Judge Advocate, and the members of the Administrative Section of the Special Actions Branch.
