BRIEF CLINICAL ABSTRACT

1. This man was initially seen in the psychiatry clinic here in August 1969, at which time separation under provisions of AR 635-212 was recommended on the basis of his "having difficulty adjusting to military life and not being able to relate to authority figures". It is noted that he has been in the army for approximately 15 months and went AWOL from the reception station after two days of active duty and stayed gone for several weeks. He was given a Special Courts Martial in the fall of 1969, and went AWOL again from the stockade and stayed gone for seven months. He was apparently awaiting another courts martial at the present time and remains in the stockade.

I think that this man has adequately demonstrated his resistance to being in the army and I would feel that he should be discharged without further complications.

2. There are no disqualifying mental or physical defects sufficient to warrant disposition through medical channels.

3. Pvt. Larry W. Priest was and is mentally responsible, able to distinguish right from wrong and to adhere to the right, and has the mental capacity to understand and participate in board proceedings.
