1. Pursuant to paragraph 48k(1) of the Manual for Courts-Martial, the detailed defense counsel request that clemency be considered in the case of U.S. v. James J. Rector. Clemency is requested for the following reasons:

a. The detailed and civilian defense counsel through the five month period of working on Rector's case had the opportunity to know and become closely acquainted with Specialist Rector and his family. During all of this time before, during and even after the court-martial, Specialist Rector never expressed bitterness against the Army or against the individual that testified against him at the court-martial.

b. At the trial, individuals testified that Specialist Rector was an excellent soldier in all ways before his court-martial.

c. Specialist Rector expressed the desire to return to duty and be given the opportunity to prove that he can once again be the type soldier that he once had proved to be.

d. Specialist Rector's First Sergeant testified at the court-martial that he would like to have Rector back in his company even though he had been found guilty of three offenses of which he had been charged.

e. The nature of the evidence against Specialist Rector and the findings in a companion case.
