## SWORN STATEMENT

I, Andre C R Fisher, WANT TO MAKE THE FOLLOWING STATEMENT UNDER OATH.

On 16 November 1969, in the company of COMPTI, Do CHUC, Do HOIA, 1LT WOOD, PFC Lazlo KONDOR, 23d Admin Co, Combat Photographer Information Office, Americal Division, C Troop, 1st Sdn, 1st Cav and B Company, 5th Bn, 46th Inf, 193th Brigade. I proceeded to Tu Cung (Ky Lai (4) to obtain photographs at the hamlet. COL TYMAN, CO, 8th MP Gp (CI), and LAC CORINNE, RM, Americal Division, also accompanied the party.

Photographs were taken on the ground and after the operation, aerial photographs were obtained from a helicopter which flew counter clock wise around Tu Cung. The Photographs were taken by KONDOR under my direction. 1LT WOOD acted as the interpreter during this mission. The mission lasted from 0800 hrs till 1130 hrs, 16 Nov 69.

The following photographs were taken:

1. Departure from Son My Village for Tu Cung, shot to front of convoy.
2. Departure from Son My Village for Tu Cung, shot to the rear of convoy.
3. Approach to Tu Cung. Tu Cung located to the north east. (Clump of trees)
4. Trail from road entering Tu Cung from the south. Note that there are no hootches on trail. During the time of the incident there were hootches there.
5. Mounds are unmarked gravesites at the southern edge of the hamlet taken from "trail" in the direction west to east, approximately 25 meters from main road leading east to west.
6. Mounds of unmarked graves. In general location of slide # 5, taken east to west.
7. Burned hootches taken from "trail" mentioned in slide # 5 taken from east to west.
8. Photograph taken north to south on the "trail" entering Tu Cung, where 40 to 50 civilians were shot. COMPTI, Do Hoia, and Do CHUC, pointing to general area. Reference is made to slide # 30. The location on this slide where the civilians were shot is on the right center section, approximately half way between clump of trees on utmost right and southern outskirts of hamlet. Tracks made run perpendicular across trail in east to west direction. On the slide the more exact location is where the tracks marks are not as obvious due to more grass and less water.
9. Taken east to west representing approximate location of 40 to 50 civilians that were shot on "trail". Civilians are represented by persons left of the APC. GATNEY and HEADLO are represented by persons to the right of the APC. (Reference slide # 30)
10. Same as # 8 taken from south to north on "trail". (Reference slide # 30)

28. Went to right 112 0000, Do C 10, Do 101A, EMER, and COMH, after the return from Tu Cung to Son My village on 10 Nov 69.

29.. Son My village with Hill 89 in back ground.

30. Overall view of Tu Cung taken from west to east. "Ditch" at top center, slightly to the right where the sparse woodline is located between the tracks. Approximately  $\frac{1}{4}$  from top of slide. "Trail" is located between clump of trees on right of slide and southern edge of hamlet.

31. View of Tu Cung from North to South.

32. View of Ditch in left/ upper corner taken from west to east.

33. View of Tu Cung from east to west.

34. Other view of Tu Cung from easterly to westerly direction.

35. View of Tu Cung from Northerly to Southerly direction. Western part of hamlet visible.

36. View of eastern part of Tu Cung, taken north to south.

37. View of Tu Cung from east to west.

38. View of Tu Cung from west to east. Ocean in background. "Ditch" is upper center of slide and trail in far right center of slide near clump of trees.

39. View of Tu Cung taken from west to east. Ocean in background. "Ditch" in center slightly up and to the left. (Sparse woodline)

40. View of Tu Cung from west to east. (Same as # 30)

41. View of Tu Cung taken from west to east along northern section of hamlet.

42. View of Tu Cung taken from west to east, also along northern section of hamlet.

43. View of southeastern part of Tu Cung taken from westerly direction. (Reference Slide # 30)

44. View of "ditch" taken from south to north. Note mounds representing unmarked graves. Flying from west to east. ( #47 was taken first, #46 second, #45, third, and #44 last)

46. Flying west to east coming up to ditch. "Ditch" is located in the tree line to the left of the tracks.

47. Flying west to east coming up to "ditch". "Ditch" located inside curve of tracks.
