MSTSPAC INSTRUCTION 3121.1C

From: Commander Military Sea Transportation Service, Pacific Area

Subj: Logistics Requirements Report (MSTSPAC Report 3121-1)

Ref: (a) NWIP 10-1(A), Articles 880-882 inclusive

1. Purpose. This instruction promulgates procedures for submission of subject report by MSTSPAC ships (except contract-operated tankers).

2. Cancellation. MSTSPACINST 3121.1B is cancelled. *

3. Information. To exercise control of and to provide logistic support to ships, MSTS activities require certain information. This instruction standardizes the method and format for submission of the Logistics Requirement Report (LOGREQ)(MSTSPAC REPT 3121-1).

4. Directive. Masters shall:

a. Forward the LOGREQ by speedletter when possible. Changes to the speedletter report shall be submitted by message seventy-two (72) hours prior to arrival or, in event of radio restrictions, whenever radio restrictions are lifted. If radio is not authorized, urgent items of the LOGREQ shall be transmitted by visual means. When the required information is not known in time to submit the LOGREQ by speedletter, it shall be submitted by message seventy-two (72) hours prior to arrival, or as soon thereafter as radio restrictions permit. When radio silence is not imposed and, in the judgment of the master, earlier submission of any item of the LOGREQ is mandatory, it may be classed as an operational message and transmitted as such.

b. Submit the LOGREQ in accordance with reference (a).

c. Include the following information in the paragraphs as indicated:

DELTA: Protected, security or special stowage cargo, and pets for discharge.

JULIETT: Crew replacements, requests for school quotas, VIP arrangements, etc.

QUEBEC: Number of cabin passengers subject to customs inspection (those passengers with baggage not cleared by pre-inspection at port of embarkation).

ZULU: 1. Number of alien passengers, excluding NATO forces. *

2. NATO forces for debarkation at a U.S. port of entry.

3. Ships scheduled to transit the Panama Canal shall include estimated draft (fore and aft) on arrival, date and time transit desired, and HYDRO requirements.
