Subj: Designation of CINCPAC military representatives for countries  
and areas of the Pacific Command  
Ref: (a) CINCPACFLT Instruction P5440.3A, Subj: PACFLT Regulation (NOTAL)

1. Purpose. The purpose of this Instruction is to implement provisions  
of reference (a).

2. Cancellation. MSTSPACINST 5820.1A is cancelled.

3. Information. In reference (a), CINCPAC designated a senior military  
representative in each country or area of the Pacific Command in which  
U. S. Military personnel are on duty. CINCPAC military representatives  
are directly responsible to CINCPAC for coordination and control of  
matters of joint concern connected with the relationships among all  
personnel under the jurisdiction of or accountable to the Department  
of Defense on the one hand, and the local people, local government  
officials, and U. S. Ambassadors on the other.

4. Area Designations. CINCPAC has designated the following commanders as  
his military representatives for the countries or areas indicated.

Korea - - COMUSKOREA (Commanding General, Eighth U. S. Army)

Japan - - COMUSJAPAN (Commander, Fifth Air Force)

Ryukyu Islands - - CINCPACREP Ryukyus (Commanding General, U. S. Army,  
Ryukyu Islands/II Corps)

Taiwan and Penghu - - COMUSTAI

Mariana-Ronin Islands - - CINCPACREP M:RBO (COMNAVMARLNAS)

Philippines - - CINCPACREP PHIL (COMNAVPHIL)

South Vietnam - - COMUSMACV

Thailand - - COMUSMACV

Australia - - CINCPACREP Australia (USAF Liaison Officer to Australia), \* except for implementation of Articles 8 and 12 of the Agreement Concerning the Status of United States Forces in Australia, which is assigned to OIC, USSSO for Australia.

Indonesia - - CHDIG Indonesia

Burma - - CHMEDT Burma

In the Hawaiian area, CINCPAC exercises his authority directly.

5. Responsibility and Functions. The military representative will (1) coordinate and direct actions by, and represent, all of the service elements in local matters of joint concern with civil government authorities, the local population, the press, and other civilian organizations; (2) coordinate, and recommend to CINCPAC, joint administrative policies and programs for the attainment of U. S. objectives in their respective areas of responsibility, and (3) keep CINCPAC, and other authorities in the normal chain of command who need to know, informed of matters which could assume serious proportions or which have serious international implications of obvious concern to higher authority.

6. Action. Commanding Officers and masters shall bring the contents of this Instruction to the attention of all MSTSPAC and/or Department of Defense personnel transiting or in countries and areas of the Pacific outside Continental United States.
