1. Purpose. This Notice promulgates an inspection forecast for MSTS ships for fiscal year 1967 as required by reference (a).

2. Inspection Procedures

a. Types of Inspections. In addition to the formal inspections required by reference (a) and scheduled in enclosure (1) hereto, the following informal inspections will be conducted by appropriate COMSTSPAC Staff personnel:

(1) Ships will be inspected informally during each inport period by personnel of cognizant offices and of the Chief Inspector's Office to assist in the correction of deficiencies and to ensure that progressive remedial action is being taken.

(2) Pre-embarkation inspections of troop spaces and facilities in transports and other ships carrying troops will be conducted as set forth in reference (b), Part 1, Chapter 9. These inspections will normally be held the day prior to embarkation and will be attended by representatives of the shipper service and, when appropriate, by the designated voyage staff.

(3) Ships returning to or leaving Full Operating Status may be given informal material and administrative inspections as conditions warrant. These inspections, when conducted, will not be graded but will be held for the primary purpose of providing assistance to the ship.

b. Notification of Inspection

(1) Notification of dates of formal inspections conducted by COMSTSPAC will be promulgated in accordance with reference (a). Timely notice of inspections conducted by other activities will be provided when firm arrangements have been completed.

3. Action. Masters and commanding officers shall utilize this Notice and enclosure (1) as guides to timely preparation for inspections.


