Subj: Pay increases for radio officers under the Pacific Schedule
of Wages - Marine Personnel (Passenger and Cargo Ships)

Ref: (a) SECNAV-MSTS 26 ltr of 19 Jan 1961 (as amended)

Encl: (1) Page 3 of the Pacific Schedule of Wages (Passenger and
Cargo Ships)

1. Reference (a) is further amended to reflect certain base pay
and premium pay changes to radio officer personnel in passenger
and cargo ships under the Pacific Schedule of Wages.

2. The specific amendments are as follows:

a. Radiotelephone operation and maintenance in cargo ships.
Effective 16 June 1965, the amount of \$11.11 per month payable to
radio officers in cargo ships for radiotelephone operation during
regular watch hours has been increased to \$15.00 per month. Effective
16 June 1965, the amount of \$11.11 per month in lieu of any
overtime for servicing the radiotelephone installation, including
repairs and batteries regardless of when or where performed, has
been increased to \$15.00 per month. These amounts are included in
the base pay for such personnel. Enclosure (1) is to be substituted
for the existing page 3 of reference (a).

b. Overtime rate. A decrease of ten cents per hour in the
overtime rate for all radio officers. On page 20 of reference (a),
paragraph II.A.2, delete "16 June 1964" and "\$4.33" and substitute
"16 June 1965" and "\$4.23" respectively.

c. Penalty time rate. An increase of sixty-four cents per
hour in the penalty time rate to all radio officers. On page 20 of
reference (a), paragraph II.A.2, delete "16 June 1964" and "\$2.86"
and substitute "16 June 1965" and "\$3.50" respectively.
