**Subj: Radio Transmitter Maintenance****A monitor report on radio transmissions from USNS POPE indicates presence of undesirable characteristics.****Listed deficiencies which may be corrected by ship's force are intermittent tone break up and echo effect.****It is requested that prompt action be taken to correct the above.****In addition to regular checks and maintenance the following is suggested:****Thoroughly clean and adjust transmitter keying relay points. Free up armature and adjust spring tension.****Clean and align hand key contact points and pivots.****If speed key is used check contact point spring tension as a possible source of echo effect.**GEORGE H.
