POINT ST GEORGE TO POINT CONCEPTION

SYNOPSIS: LOW PRESSURE AREA CENTERED EAST OF UTAH.  
EASTERN PACIFIC HIGH PRESSURE 1028 MB CENTERED 1000 MILES WEST -  
SOUTHWEST SAN FRANCISCO WITH RIDGE HIGH PRESSURE EXTENDING NNE TO  
EASTERN GULF ALASKA. PRESSURE GRADIENT BETWEEN THESE SYSTEMS  
CAUSING N WINDS ALONG CALIFORNIA COAST.

FORECAST: N TO NW WIND 15 TO 30 KTS IN N AND W TO NW WIND 10 TO 20  
KTS IN S THROUGH FRIDAY NIGHT.  
LOCALLY STRONGER WINDS NEAR HEADLANDS.  
CONSIDERABLE LOW CLOUDINESS CLEARING SOMEWHAT DURING AFTERNOON.
