

WEATHER - KFS SAN FRANCISCO 06 1620Z JUNE 1968

SYNOPSIS

LOW PRESS OVER THE INTERMOUNTAIN AREA ARE A LITTLE FARTHER EAST THIS MORNING THAN YESTERDAY. THE EASTERN PACIFIC HIGH PRESSURE CENTER OF 1027 MBS IS LOCATED 1200 MILES WEST OF SAN DIEGO WITH A RIDGE OF HIGH PRESSURE EXTENDING NORTHEAST TO ABOUT 500 MILES WEST OF CRESCENT CITY CALIFORNIA. THE RESULTANT PRESSURE FIELD IS CAUSING NORTHERLY WINDS ALONG THE CALIFORNIA COAST. WINDS ARE NEAR NORMAL FOR THIS TIME OF YEAR.

FORECAST -

NORTHWESTERLY WINDS 15 TO 25 KTS BUT LOCALLY STRONGER NEAR HEADLANDS THROUGH FRIDAY.
PARTLY CLOUDY.
