INSTRUCTION SHEET

This sheet provides instructions for effecting Change 7 to the Sonar Chapter of the Electronics Installation and Maintenance Book. The enclosed material is to be incorporated into the Sonar Handbook, NAVSHIPS 0967-000-0030 (formerly NAVSHIPS 900,000.3).

The purpose of this change is to update the Sonar Handbook through the addition of new material to Sections 3 and 4 (FCIG and Service Notes). Affected FRONT MATTER has also been revised to reflect this change and is included in this package.*

The procedures for executing this change are set forth in the following paragraphs.

1. Remove all superseded pages and insert changed pages as indicated below:
