Refr: (a) MSTSPAC INSTRUCTION 12593.1

1. In accordance with reference (a), you are hereby authorized to assign one cook within your present crew complement to serve a hot midnight lunch to the following crew members:


(a) Masters-at-arms and watchmen (fire) whose 8-hour tours of duty either end at 2400 or commence at 0001.

(b) Deck officers, radio officers, quartermasters and able seamen who have the 2000-2400 and 0001-0400 sea watches.

(c) Engine officers, oilers, firemen-watertenders, electricians and refrigeration engineers who have the 2000-2400 and 0001-0400 sea watches.

(d) Night pantrymen, bakers, cooks and other ratings whose tours of duty encompass the hours 2000 and 0400.

2. Serving of the hot lunch shall commence at 2330 and cease at 0030. The cook and night pantrymen shall clean up after serving the meal.
