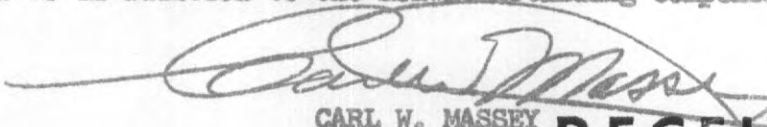

Subj: Nonwatchstanding and premium pay compensation to nonwatchstanding officers assigned temporarily to watches; clarification of

MSTSPAC Speedletter Ser: P21/4354 of 23 August 1966 is hereby cancelled in consonance with new guidelines furnished by COMSTS.

In accordance with COMSTS msg 051752Z Aug 1966 (NOTAL), when deck or engine licensed officer nonwatchstanding personnel are temporarily assigned to watches due to the current shortage of licensed personnel, nonwatchstanding compensation will be paid these officers notwithstanding the fact that they are temporarily assigned to watch duties.

When any nonwatchstanding licensed deck officers, excluding the Master, or non-watchstanding licensed assistant engineers are required to stand regular watches, premium pay is not authorized for standing sea watches that do not exceed 8 hours per day in the aggregate, Monday through Friday. They will receive penalty time for sea watches stood on Saturdays and Sundays, and overtime for such watches stood on holidays. This will be in addition to the nonwatchstanding compensation.
