REASONS FOR CHANGES

CMPI 610.3-1a.--Amended by setting forth the conditions for payment of overtime to engine officers (Atlantic Schedule) for work in excess of eight hours when port time, or a combination of port time and sea time, is in effect.

CMPI 610.6-1f.--Amended to include the payment of penalty time to licensed deck officers (Pacific Schedule) in continental ports for cargo work during regular hours when longshoremen are unavailable. Heretofore, this applied in foreign ports only.

CMPI 610.7-1a.--Amended by setting forth the conditions for payment of overtime to engine officers (Pacific Schedule) for work in excess of eight hours when port time, or a combination of port time and sea time, is in effect.

CMPI 610.8-2a.--Amended to include only those provisions that are applicable to steward personnel (Pacific Schedule) in passenger ships. There is no change in the actual work practice for this category.

CMPI 610.8-2b.--The relocation (formerly CMPI 610.8-2a) of the work practices for steward personnel (Pacific Schedule) in other than passenger ships. In addition, it now provides for a change in the regular working hours for steward personnel in special project ships who furnish service to noncrewmembers.

CMPI 610.8-2c.--Formerly CMPI 610.8-2b and further amended by substituting the word "Saturday" in the last line for "Friday".

CMPI 610.8-2d.--A new paragraph which incorporates the existing premium pay provisions for steward personnel (Pacific Schedule) formerly contained in CMPI 610.8-2a.

CMPI 610.8-3b.--A new clause added which prohibits overtime to steward personnel (Pacific Schedule) in special project ships when a night meal is prepared and served at sea unless such work is in excess of the regular eight hours.

PEN CHANGES

Page 49, CMPI 610.7-1e, delete the two consecutive sentences beginning with the word "This" in the third line and ending with the word "departure." in the sixth line. The concurrent amendment to CMPI 610.7-1a now governs the applicability of overtime relating to the deleted provision.
