TO WHOM IT MAY CONCERN:

At about 1530 hours, 27 February 1968, I noticed J. JENSEN, 33535, Engine Utilityman, was not working in the After Engine room where he had been assigned. I found him in room 201, apparently under the influence of liquor. I ordered him ashore.

At about 1630, I received word he was making a nuisance of himself in the dining room. I found him there and ordered him off the ship. After several starts, I finally got him to the gangway and ashore.

Some ten (10) minutes later, I was notified that he was injured and unconscious on the dock. I went out on the dock and found him lying down, bleeding around the forehead. A security guard told me an ambulance had been called and I stayed there until the ambulance took JENSEN away - a matter of about five (5) minutes.
