Subj: Safety meeting; report on

1. Safety meeting for the Engine Department personnel was called to order at 1300, 27 October 1967, with the Chief Engineer presiding. Thirty-seven (37) men were present.
2. The minutes of the last meeting were read and approved. Deficiencies were all corrected.
3. Report of Command Safety Council; action on, dated 25 September 1967, was reviewed and discussed, emphasizing items on disabling accidents. Proceedings of the Merchant Marine Council report of 29 September 1967 was also read and discussed. Several articles of significant accident prevention published in Safety Review of April 1967 and Safety Newsletter of July 1967 were read and discussed.
4. Personnel were reminded again while the ship at Shipyard to be safety conscious. Men using chemicals must follow instructions on can how to use it or else if not followed will cause bad burns on hands.
5. Personnel using grinding and buffing machines, material rest must be close enough to stone or brush and not permit material to pass between rest and stone or wire wheel, this will avoid entangling the material in the wheel.
6. Meeting was adjourned at 1345.
