Subj: Safety meeting and Moral Leadership; report on

5. A 5-minute Safety Talk, entitled, "FIRST AID - BETTER THAN NO AID", taken from Industrial Supervisor Booklet, issue of June 1967, was read and discussed.
6. The Chief Engineer gave a short talk on Moral Leadership.
7. Meeting was adjourned at 1335.
