REMARKS

I, the undersigned diver, did on the above date make an underwater inspection of the rolling-chocks of the above named vessel.

I found that about 6 ft. of the forward end of the starboard rolling chock was loose from the hull and about 3 ft. of the forward end of the after section loose. I burnt these off and examined the rest of the starboard rolling chock and found no further damage.
