

Captain's Inspection

11 August 1967

The following is a report of the Captain's Inspection held this date, with general remarks following at the end of same.

1. 02-116-1-L Dirt underneath the mattress and in spring.
2. Shower- 03 Aft. Put new hooks on shower curtain and drop 2-3 inches.  
( Qtr. Mstrs')
3. 1-170-2-L Shower curtains filled with mold.
4. 1-170-1-L Toilet seats green and filthy - CLEAN UP
5. ATTENTION: MASTER AT ARMS... remove all posters on bulkheads that are put up with masking tape and replace with frames.
6. Ch. Electr's Shorten shower curtains in Wash Room  
State Room
7. 2-155-4-L Install ventilation duct overhead.
8. 2-170-4-L Clean up tile and deck.
9. 2-173-6 Remove lewd pictures from the bulkhead.
10. All Laundry Post operating instructions for the operation of  
Rooms washing machines.
11. All Quarters Replace dirty wastebaskets with new ones.
12. 3-130-3-L Replace vent. duct.
13. 3-126-1-L Replace vent. duct and wastebasket.
14. 3-118-3-E Stain deck in CO<sub>2</sub> Room.
15. CPO MESS Vent. duct not functioning- Fan does not oscillate.  
( Stbd.) Ch. Electrician- lower fan 2-3 inches overall.
16. Crew Scullery Make fan to oscillate. Step up exhaust on the  
dishwasher. \* Shine up brass valve stems and  
paint valves.
17. Mil. Mess Put roach spray in the storage cabinet.  
( Port Side)
18. 1st. Engr. Polish valve stems with crocus cloth and paint the  
handles jet black or glossy black before arrival  
in San Francisco.
19. 3-144-2-L Replace wastebasket.

Captain's Remarks:

Watch out for the shower curtains: many of them are filled up with mold.

The overall condition of the ship is very good. We will have one more inspection prior to arrival in San Francisco, one week from today.

Louvers from the ventilation ducts will not be removed primarily due to the imbalance of the whole system.
