2. ALL COMPARTMENT NCO'S will stand by their compartments for the 1000 and 2200 hour inspection. All compartments, ladderwells, and recreation rooms will be cleaned and ready for inspection at the above times.

3. UNIT COMMANDERS are reminded that they retain Article 15 jurisdiction over their personnel. In addition to the punishments normally available to the Unit Commander, the ship's brig can be used for confinement for a period not to exceed 7 consecutive days or 3 consecutive days on bread and water. Appeals to Article 15 punishment should be addressed to the Senior Unit Commander. Any questions regarding administration should be directed to the Adjutant in the Troop Office.

4. T-shirts, shorts, and shower shoes are NOT AUTHORIZED for wear on deck. The only uniform authorized for wear are as follows: fatigues, khakis, or flight suits with boots, military low-quarters, or sneakers. Violators of the uniform regulation are subject to disciplinary action.

5. If MAN OVERBOARD is sounded, go to your cabin or compartment and standby for muster if directed. Under any circumstances, remain clear of rescue operations.

6. The BARBER SHOP is open from 0800 to 1000 hours daily for all officers and NCO's (E6 and above). The barber shop is open to enlisted personnel from 1300 hours to 1800 hrs daily. Haircuts will be administered on a compartment rotation basis. The compartment rotation schedule is as follows:

DAY	COMPARTMENT
Saturday	2-2, 4-7, 4-5
Sunday	Closed
Monday	3-2, 3-3
Tuesday	4-2, 3-7
Wednesday	4-3, 4-6
Thursday	2-7, 2-3
Friday	KP's, guards, and other detail personnel

*Chow cards will be presented prior to entering shop

7. SUNBATHING is authorized only on the Sundeck from 1300 to 1700 hours daily. Swimming suits or shorts may be worn for sunbathing ONLY. The wearing of swimming suits or shorts any place except the sundeck will be considered an infraction of the uniform regulation and the violator subject to disciplinary action.

8. The compartment which is judged best during the daily inspection for five consecutive days will be given a guided tour of the bridge and ship.
