Subj: Duty Corpsman; responsibilities and duties of

1. Purpose. The purpose of this instruction is to establish the responsibilities and duties of the Duty Corpsman.

2. General.


a. All duty corpsmen will be in the designated uniform of the day.

b. The duty corpsman will be responsible for the cleanliness of Sick Bay. They will assure themselves that the spaces are clean prior to relieving the watch. If any discrepancies are noted they will be brought to the attention of the Division Leading Petty Officer or the Medical Administrative Assistant, as the case may be, before liberty is granted.

c. The duty section will consist of one man. He will maintain a security and Medical watch in the Sick Bay at all times. In port if he finds it necessary to depart from the Sick Bay, he will keep the Quarterdeck notified of his whereabouts at all times.

d. The duty section will comply with the specific duties of the duty section as listed in MEDDEPTINSTS 6010.1 and 6010.6.

e. Hours of duty shall be in accordance with MEDDEPTINST 6010.1, para 3b.
