Subj: Medical Maximum Security Rooms

1. Purpose. The purpose of this instruction is to describe the location of, the procedure to be used in, and the responsibility for the care of the Medical Maximum Security Rooms.

2. Location. The Medical Maximum Security Rooms, labeled labeled Cells are located in the Medical Department Spaces on the 01 deck, aft of frame 106 on the starboard passageway. They consist of five self-locking, ventilated, and exteriorly lighted cells separated by a passageway with a head located in the aft end.

3. Responsibility. Male patients admitted to the Medical Maximum Security Rooms shall come under the immediate care of the Ward Corpsman who shall visit the rooms hourly to determine the status of the patient. He will, during these visits, allow the patient to make head calls and to obtain water and fluids.

4. General. Patients placed in the Medical Maximum Security Rooms will have all personal effects removed except for underclothing, and these personal effects will be placed under the custody of the Medical Administrative Assistant.


5. Security.

a. Books may be brought to the rooms, but no other articles without the permission of the Medical Officer.

b. During meals a corpsman will be present and sure insure that no utensils are missing or misused.

c. The only furnishings in the room shall be a mattress with sheets and blanket.

d. Visitors will not be allowed the patient, unless so directed by the Medical Officer.


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
