Subj: Isolation of Communicable Disease Patients

1. Purpose. The purpose of this instruction is to establish location for and policies regarding isolation of patients with Communicable Diseases.
2. Location. Special isolation areas are
 - a. Isolation Room (01-121-4-L)
 - b. Isolation Room (01-134-2-L)
 - c. Isolation Room (01-138-4-L)
3. Responsibility. As the control of communicable disease is the primary responsibility of the Medical Officer, he will designate the type of isolation depending on the disease, severity of the individual case, and current BUMED directives.
4. General.
 - a. Sterile technique will be used by the Corpsmen in the care of these patients.
 - b. No visitors will be allowed these patients unless authorized by the Medical Officer.
