1. In accordance with reference (a) the ENGINE Departmental semi-monthly Safety and Moral Leadership meeting was held from 1200 to 1235 this date with 21 men attending. The meeting was conducted by Mr. M. S. CHAMBERLAIN, Chief Engineer.
2. Since the last departmental Safety and Moral Leadership meeting there have been no lost time accidents and no first aid injuries in the Engine department.
3. The following five minute Safety Talk, Book # 2 Talk #32 Title "WHY STRAIN YOUR BACK" was given. Five minute Safety Talk from MSTS Safety Manual/COMSTS Instr-5100-17 Chapter = Subject = can be also used in lieu of 5-minute Safety Talk Books.
4. The principal topics were discussed; safety suggestions made, and Safety hazards noted, are as follows:
 - (a) Never put cigarette butts on soot in buckets.
 - (b) Keep all Portholes and Weather deck doors closed.
 - (c) Pump Failure causes Woe.
 - (d) Personnel were told to report to head of department of previous injuries resulting personal weakness.
5. Other subject (s) were discussed: Moral Leadership
 1. Several articles published in Safety Newsletter, Marine Section, issue of July and August 1968 were read and discussed.
 2. Also Safe Worker and Safe Driver booklets, issue of September 1968 were read and discussed to the personnel present.
