Subj: Safety meeting - USNS POPE AND USNS WEIGEL

1. A safety meeting was held for thirteen men of the Deck and three men of the Steward Departments between 0920 and 0945, 14 February 1969.
2. There weren't any reported injuries since our last meeting.
3. Boatswain Leonard Hemphill recommended two padeyes be placed on the portside of accommodation ladder on USNS POPE ladder. These padeyes are to be used when lifting ladder into stowed position. A repair request is prepared to have this accomplished.
4. There were no safety suggestion coming from USNS WEIGEL.
5. Form CA-10 "WHAT A FEDERAL EMPLOYEE SHOULD DO WHEN INJURED ON THE JOB", was discussed. This form was posted for all hands to study.
6. The men present were reminded to practice cooperative safety. They were told to caution shipmates when unsafe practices were noticed.
