PRECEDENCE: ASSIGNED LOWEST PRECEDENCE CONSISTENT WITH THE IMPORTANCE OF CASUALTY, CURRENT OPERATIONAL SCHEDULE AND TACTICAL SITUATION.

CLASSIFICATION: CASREPT MSGS SHOULD BE CLASSIFIED ONLY AS NECESSARY TO ENSURE SECURITY OF CLASSIFIED INFORMATION. IF POSSIBLE, REPORTS ON COLLISIONS WITH A MERCHANT VESSEL SHOULD NOT BE CLASSIFIED
