2. In accordance with reference (e) the following provisions govern personnel assigned in USNS POPE during the time the ship remains in ready reserve status and serves as the mother ship for other RRS ships:

- a. The administrative workweek for officers and nonofficers shall be five consecutive days of eight hours each, Monday through Sunday. The workweek may be staggered to begin on any day of the week.
- b. Overtime shall be paid for all work in excess of eight hours per day and forty hours per week and for work performed on holidays. Overtime is not payable for work performed on Saturdays and Sundays if these days fall within the regular forty-hour workweek.
3. Payment of cash in lieu of subsistence and quarters in kind is authorized through close of business 15 October 1969 in accordance with reference (f). Effective 16 October 1969 subsistence and quarters in kind will be furnished to personnel in USNS POPE and personnel of other ships as may be designated.
