2. In accordance with reference (b) a replacement reserve is not authorized. Crew members will take annual or sick leave from the ship rather than the receiving branch.


3. In accordance with references (d) and (e), the following provisions govern personnel assigned during the time the ship remains in ready reserve status:

a. The administrative workweek for officers and nonofficers shall be five consecutive days of eight hours each, Monday through Sunday. The workweek may be staggered to begin on any day of the week.

b. Overtime shall be paid for all work in excess of eight hours per day and forty hours per week and for work performed on holidays. Overtime is not payable for work performed on Saturdays and Sundays if these days fall within the regular forty-hour workweek.

c. Deck and engine department officers are not entitled to additional monthly nonwatchstanding compensation and radio officers are not entitled to compensation for radio station tests under the provisions of reference (e) while the ship remains in ready reserve status.

d. Cash in lieu of subsistence and quarters is authorized during the period this manning scale is in effect unless otherwise directed in accordance with reference (f).
