MSTS will furnish a LCM 3 boat for crew liberty service for all USNS and GAA Ships at these hours. These are the only boats that will come alongside (except cargo lighterage) USNS and GAA Ships.

1. Boat will depart Commerical Fish Pier making ships starting at in-board side to pipeline and returning from pipeline to ships then to Commerical Fish Piers.
2. Anyone under influence who cannot climb Jacobs ladder are requested not to ride boat and will be refused passage by boat crew.
3. Only Jacobs ladder will be used for embarkation and debarkation of crew members. LCM will not go alongside accommodation ladder because of possible damage.
4. Maximum of two minutes is allowed for waiting alongside. Request Master insure word is passed that liberty boat is approaching ship. Also request mate on watch inform boat coxswain if no passengers are available for embarkation so that unnecessary delays can be avoided.
5. Military buses are available inside gate for transportation to MACV Compound and Military Medical Facilities. ID Cards are required.
